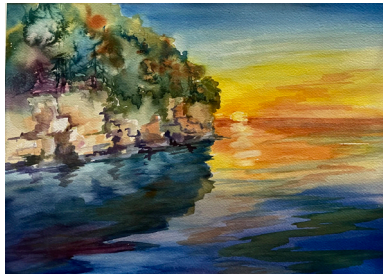
The WIAA follows CDC guidelines for our workshops. The capacity of our workshops will be limited. Sign up early!
